

# From The Rabbi's Study...

#### **The Day After Passover**

As you are reading this, Passover has recently ended. The countless hours of cleaning and preparing are over, our Seders have concluded, and many of us most likely rushed out to have that "traditional" pizza dinner as soon as the holiday ended. I must confess that each year as Passover winds down in my house I am a bit daunted by the task of cleaning up from the holiday, particularly when it comes to switching over all of the dishes, silverware, and food, as we prepare to go back to our "normal" lives. It seems like there is always so much to clean up and put away in order to set things in order in the house and to proceed on with the rest of the Jewish year. I am often very thoughtful and intentional about how and where I store things away so that I will remember them for next year. But while I put much work and thought into changing my surroundings back from "Passover" to "normal," I often fail to take a few moments for thoughtful reflection about how Passover has "changed" my life.

If our transition out of Passover places us in the same "state" as we were in before Passover, than we have missed something. The lessons of Passover are supposed to change us in some way. We are supposed to personalize the Passover experience by seeing ourselves as if we had actually left Egypt, is another way of saying that we are supposed to let the Passover experience be a transformative one. There are a number of inherent values that Passover is supposed to teach us. We are supposed to spend time remembering that we were slaves and pondering the implications of this part of our story as a people. We are taught to celebrate the Freedom that came out of this slavery by focusing on the meaning of freedom in our lives today as well as the world around us. We are reminded that we must be hospitable and caring towards one another and towards strangers because we were strangers in the land of Egypt. We celebrate the gift of food that most of us are privileged to have in abundance and acknowledge the responsibility to help all who are hungry in our community and in this world. Finally, we take time to explore our connection to the Jewish people from the time of the Exodus until today, reflecting upon our place in the narrative of the Jewish people. Each of these values are critical to the celebration of Passover, but if we move forward without exploring how these values have changed the way in which we live our daily lives than we have not taken full advantage of the meaning behind this wonderful holiday. So, now that you have (hopefully) finished all of the shlepping of your dishes from one cabinet to another, putting away the left over Passover cake meal, and donating those extra few boxes of matzah (because, of course, you had too many!) I invite you to take a few moments to think about how your "post Passover" experience will be different from your "pre Passover" one. Have the values and experiences of this holiday changed you in some way? How might your daily behavior be different because of your Passover celebration? Of all of the questions that you have asked on Passover, perhaps this is the most important one.






