



From The Rabbi's Study...

Daily Minyan- A Life Changing Mitzvah

One of the most inspiring things about our congregation is the blessing of our daily minyan. In addition to providing a few moments of quiet prayer and reflection, our *minyanim* provide a space for members of CTE to connect to one another and to God, and give those who have suffered a loss the opportunity to say the Mourner's Kaddish.

According to Jewish tradition, anyone who has lost a parent, a child, a sibling, or a spouse is to say Kaddish in a minyan for their loved one. All mourners are required to say Kaddish for the thirty-day period following the funeral, and children who have lost a parent are obligated to continue saying kaddish daily for eleven months. After the initial post-death period, mourners continue to say kaddish periodically, four times a year at the holiday Yizkor services, and annually honoring the anniversary of the death, called the Yartzeit.

Traditionally speaking, no one can say Kaddish without a minyan. The question is why? Why is it so important to gather ten Jews together in order to say kaddish? Doesn't God hear all prayer? Does it really matter if the Mourner's Kaddish is said in a minyan? Couldn't a business traveler just say kaddish alone in her hotel room? Or couldn't a busy dad say kaddish in between work and carpool pick up?

Yes, God hears all prayer. But no, one can't, and should not, say kaddish alone. Saying Kaddish in a minyan really does matter. Patti Moskowitz put this very well in her book entitled *The Minyan*, when she wrote:

Elie Wiesel once said that a Jew does not, and indeed cannot exist in isolation. Jews live in community. While it is true that a Jew can pray alone and study alone, Jewish existence finds its truest expression in the company of other Jews (87-88)

Minyan expresses the value of community. At no time is the importance of community more critical than when one of its members has suffered the loss of a loved one. Our tradition is clear: A person in mourning must not be alone. The presence and power of prayer and community after a death can change the life of both those who give and those who receive comfort.

But gathering together as a minyan is not just for those who are in mourning. There are many other reasons to come to minyan. Let's face it: it is not often that we manage to carve out time in our busy schedules to join together with members of our community and make space to discover God's presence in our lives. We are usually so busy that it seems hard enough to keep in touch with close family and friends. Making time to figure out where God fits into the picture often becomes a lower priority. Fortunately, minyan provides us with that gift and opportunity each and every day.

All of us are busy and there are all sorts of reasons that we can each think of for not showing up. The time does not work for us. We have to be home to help with our children. Our favorite class at the gym meets at the exact same time. It is too cold outside—let someone else drive to minyan. Each of these reasons is legitimate. But helping to make a minyan is not about any one of us individually. It is about all of us collectively.

We have been having some challenges with minyan lately. We are largely successful and are truly blessed to have such dedicated minyanairs. But over the past few months some members of our community have come to say kaddish and have been unable to do so because we have not had a minyan. That simply should not be. And so, I am asking for your help.

We often send out letters inviting people to come for a yahrtzeit and are now beginning to send weekly phone messages to small groups of you and make personal phone calls in order to ensure that we have a minyan. If you get a letter or a phone call, please try to come to minyan. And in general, please consider the following: Can you come once a week? Can you come once a month? Can you come three times this year? Each of us has to make a personal decision based on our own schedules and availability. Regardless of how often you can make this happen, I hope each one of you will be willing to make a personal commitment.

Here at Congregation Torat El we are striving to build kehillah kedosah, holy community. Making time to support our fellow members in need, and taking a few moments of quiet prayer and reflection in our own personal lives is critical to that effort. Please join us weekdays: Monday-Friday 8 am (Roseld), 7:30 pm (Monmouth) Sunday, 8:30 am (Roseld), Friday nights 6:30 (Monmouth), Shabbat morning 9:00 am (Monmouth). We are looking forward to praying with you!

Ron Wolfson

Ron Wolfson is a visionary Jewish educator whose enthusiasm for bringing Judaism alive in homes and synagogues has shaped his work in the community. He is the author most recently of *The Seven Questions You're Asked in Heaven: Reviewing and Renewing Your Life on Earth, The Spirituality of Welcoming: How to Transform Your Congregation Into a Sacred Community,* and *God's To-Do List: 103 Ways to Be an Angel and Do God's Work on Earth* (Jewish Lights Publishing). A pioneer in the field of Jewish family education, Ron has authored *The Art of Jewish Living* series of books (Jewish Lights Publishing): Three of the titles (Shabbat, The Passover, Hanukkah) are designed to enrich the celebration of Jewish holidays, and one (*A Time to Mourn, A Time to Comfort*) provides a guide to Jewish bereavement and comfort.

Ron is currently the Fingerhut Professor of Education at the American Jewish University (formerly the University of Judaism) in Los Angeles where he has been a member of the faculty since 1975. He has also served as Dean of the Fingerhut School of Education, Vice President and Founding Director of the Whizin Center for the Jewish Future and the Whizin Institute for Jewish Family Life. The book, *First Fruit: A Whizin Anthology of Jewish Family Education*, which he co-edited with Adrianne Bank, won the 1999 Jewish Book Award. Ron's interest in synagogues dates back to his involvement in a Conservative congregation, Beth El, in his home town of Omaha, Nebraska. Over the years, he has visited hundreds of synagogues across North America as a consultant, teacher and scholar in residence widely recognized for his passionate, insightful and often humorous presentations. Ron is a co-founder of Synagogue 2000 (with Rabbi Lawrence Hoffman) and currently serves as President of Synagogue 3000, a catalyst for excellence, empowering congregations and communities to create synagogues that are sacred and vital centers of Jewish life.
