From The Rabbi's Study...

Happy New Year! A Look Back As We Look Ahead



Each year on Rosh Hashanah, we are afforded the opportunity to take a closer look at our lives. As we prepare for Rosh Hashanah we spend a tremendous amount of time looking backward, reflecting on the past year, and thinking about how we might change in the year to come. We think about the people we have wronged, and we ask their forgiveness.

Our secular new year is somewhat different. Instead of focusing on the year that has passed, we tend to make New Year's resolutions that focus more on the year to come. We say, this will be the year that we exercise more, spend more time with our family, or spend more time volunteering. While looking forward with a sense of purpose and direction is valuable, taking time to reflect on our past and using our past to inform our future is a quintessentially Jewish way to approach our new year. Every time we put the Torah away the last words we say are "*chadesh yameynu k'kedem*," *Renew our lives as in days of old*. In other words, as Jews we value looking toward the past and allowing the lessons that we have learned to renew our future.

What does this mean in practical terms as we begin the year 2013? By the time that you are reading this, your New Year's parties will have ended, the resolutions will have been made (and hopefully some of them are still taking hold), and we will be a few weeks into the new calendar year. But it is never too late to reflect back on the year that has passed. Here are a few questions to get you started.

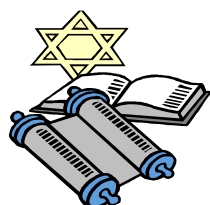
1. What brought you the most joy in 2012 and what brought you the most pain?
2. What was your proudest achievement in the year 2012?
3. What was your greatest learning experience in 2012?
4. Who did you hurt in 2012 and what, if anything, can you do to improve that relationship in the year 2013?
5. What was your greatest Jewish experience in 2012 and what Jewish experiences do you hope to have in 2013?
6. What are you most grateful for as you look past at the year 2012, and how will that affect the way you approach the year 2013?

Take a few moments to think about the answers to these questions. Write them down, discuss them with your family. By looking backwards before we look forward, Judaism reminds us that we can never fully be attuned to the future unless we honor, remember, and value the past.

Now to looking ahead: here is a practical suggestion (one that I found on several friends' facebook pages) to help you become more attuned to the blessings in your life. Create a "Blessings Jar" -- buy a big jar and keep it on the counter with pens and small pieces of colorful paper nearby. Throughout the year, when you and your family members experience a time of happiness, gratitude, and blessing, take a moment to write it down on a slip of paper and stick it in the jar. On January 1, 2014, take out the pieces of paper and read them as a powerful way to look back at the blessings that filled the last year.

May this year be filled with health and happiness for you and your family and may the lessons of the year that has passed inform the year to come, bringing blessing, purpose, and thoughtfulness into our lives and into our world.

NEW RELIGIOUS SCHOOL STRUCTURE

Effective January 1, 2013, the Rabbi Jacob Friedman Religious School at Congregation Torat El is implementing a new structure. The goal of the structure change is to maintain the integrity of Religious School objectives and curriculum while responding to today's changing environment. In addition, since the Sunday hours will be expanded, this will provide the Religious School, and the Temple as a whole, with an opportunity to enhance Temple programming on Sundays.

Effective January 1, 2013, the formal Religious School hours are as follows:

Ganon/Kindergarten	Every Sunday 9 - 10:30 A.M. (No Change)
Grades 1-2	Every Sunday 9 - 11:30 A.M.
Grades 3-6	Every Sunday 9 - 11:30 A.M. AND every Wednesday 4:15 - 6:15 P.M.
Grade 7	Every Wednesday 4:15 - 6:15 P.M. AND monthly Mitzvah Field Trips.
Hebrew High	Every Wednesday 6:15 P.M.-8:15 P.M.

Service requirements remain as is: 3 times per school year for 3rd graders, 4 times for 4th graders, 5 times for 5th graders, 6 times for 6th graders, and 3 times per month for students within a year from his/her Bar/Bat Mitzvah.

In order for this change to be successful in maintaining the integrity of the Religious School goals and curriculum, it is important that the parents accept and endorse the change. Please help us by ensuring that your child maintains a high rate of attendance on Sundays AND Wednesdays, and that they continue to attend Services regularly. We also ask the parents to continue to remain involved and committed to our programs.

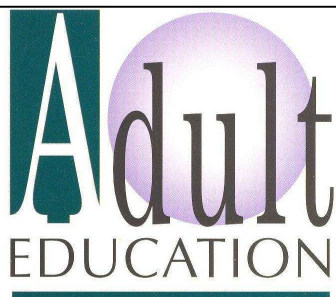
