## The Challenge of "The New Year's Resolution"



Happy belated Thanksgiving! Happy Belated Hanukkah! And Happy New Year! I have missed all of you over these past few months of my sabbatical. I cannot thank you enough for granting me the opportunity to reflect, replenish, and renew my physical, emotional, and spiritual self over these past few months. As I re-enter into synagogue life in the coming weeks, I am greatly looking forward to sharing my learning and reflections with you. In the meantime, I will start with just one piece of learning as we enter into a new secular year.

Over the past few months I have been taking a course in the study of Mussar. Literally meaning "correction" or "instruction," and also used to mean "ethics" in modern Hebrew, the Mussar movement developed in the second half of the nineteenth century and was founded by Rabbi Israel Salanter. But in reality Mussar is "most accurately described as a way of life." (Morinis, Everyday Holiness)

The goal of Mussar is to remember that the Torah calls us to "be holy (Lev. 19)" and that we are to strive to bring holiness to all aspects of our lives. And just how do we reach such a high spiritual level? We begin by working on ourselves, as we strive to balance our strengths and weaknesses and live up to our divine potential. As Dr. Alan Morinis explains:

When all is said and done, holiness and wholeness and any other elevated idea of the spiritual goal come down to the simple Yiddish notion: you are supposed to be a mensch, which means "a decent human being.."

In the words of the Chassidic teacher, known as the Kotzker, 'Fine,' he says, 'be holly. But remember first one has to be a mensch (15).'

As we reach yet another new year, with our secular custom of making resolutions and resolving to improve our actions, behaviors, and habits, it strikes me that my studies over these past few months have quite a bit to teach us about the challenges and opportunities of creating true and lasting change, as we work to become *mensches* and ensure that our new year's resolutions actually stick. You see, according to Dr. Morinis, each of us has our own personal "curriculum" in our life.

The behaviors that dunk you in the same soup, time and time again. You probably can identify one or two of these patterns without much effort, in string of soured, or even broken relationships, in financial dreams that are never realized, in fulfillment that is forever elusive.... The sooner you become familiar with your curriculum and get on with mastering it, the faster you'll get free of these habitual patterns. Then you will suffer less. Then you will cause less suffering for others. Then you will make the contribution to the world that is your unique and highest potential (3)."

Over these past weeks and months I have been reflecting, and working, on my own personal curriculum, through the lens of the great Mussar teachers of the 19th and 20th centuries. Through weekly reading, partnering with a colleague, and striving to incorporate basic techniques to put what I am learning into practice, I have begun to focus my energy on striving to nurture my own inner character as I seek to engage with those areas in life in which I am successful and those areas in life with which I struggle. As of this writing, I have learned about teachings related to humility, patience, gratitude, compassion, order, equanimity (lit. creating a soul at rest), and honor. Future topics that I will be studying through the year include concepts such as generosity, silence, moderation, responsibility, loving kindness, faith, and trust.

The truth is that any one of these topics can take a lifetime's worth of focus. Each one of us has our own successes to take pride in, and our own challenges to contend with, when it comes to improving upon our spirit, developing our own characters, and working on our daily interactions with others. Some of us are more patient than others. Some of us are kinder than others. Some of us are good at keeping calm and others less so. Some of us are truly humble and others often feign humility. Whatever our strengths and weaknesses, I have been reminded through this study and practice that this type of inner work takes time. It takes discipline. And it takes a willingness to look honestly at ourselves. Unfortunately, there are no quick fixes to this type of work. The New Year might be a good time to reflect upon what we wish to improve upon, but a resolution is empty unless we are willing to put in the work each and every hour of each and every day. The Mussar tradition reminds us that striving to improve ourselves, by learning from our life's curriculum can help us to become better grandparents, parents, children, siblings, spouses, colleagues, and friends. But only if we are willing to continually focus, and practice, when it comes to those areas of our inner souls upon which we seek to improve.

What is our inner curriculum? What are the strengths of our character and what are our weaknesses? How can we strive to reach our highest potential by remembering that many of our choices each day are just that — **our** choices. Over the coming months I will be incorporating some of what I have learned into my teachings and I will look forward to exploring these questions together with you using the wisdom of Mussar as our guide.

I am looking forward to catching up with all of you and learning together in the weeks and months to come. May this be a year of health and happiness and meaning for you and your families!
