## FROM THE DESK OF LAWRENCE SHAPIRO

I want to thank those of you who took the time to call, email, or write me with your feedback and comments, both positive and negative, as to Rabbi Schonbrun and Rabbi Metz. Your input was informative, insightful and extremely helpful in leadership's evaluation of the Rabbis as we approach the time for consideration of the renewal of their respective contracts.

As many of you heard at our recent Congregation Meeting, Congregation Torat El will not be renewing Rabbi Metz's contract when it expires at the end of June 2017. This is due to a broad range of factors and budgetary considerations. Simply put, our staffing model of an Assistant Rabbi/Educator was something we tried, and ultimately do not require at this time.

I have spoken to Rabbi Metz and true to the professional that she is, she understood the decision. She assured us that she will honor her contractual commitments until the end of her term, or she leaves for another congregation, for which we would not stand in her way. We are in the process of securing interim help while Rabbi Metz is on maternity leave in the fall. We will actively search for a new Religious School Director for the 2017-18 school year, and will be seeking congregant, and in particular, parent involvement in that process.

We have spoken to the teachers, the Education Committee and temple leadership to ensure a smooth transition during Rabbi Metz's maternity leave, and then again prior to the 2017-18 school year.

Change is never easy. However, I am confident that we as a community will work together to make sure each of our students continues to have a successful and meaningful education experience.

With regard to Rabbi Schonbrun, I am pleased to report that months before the contractual requirement to do so, he has expressed his desire to stay at Congregation Torat El. In response, we have expressed our desire to have him stay and we are actively negotiating what we hope will be a long-term extension of his contract.

I look forward to keeping you updated as we continue to move forward with these important processes.

## PRESENCE AS A SPIRITUAL DISCIPLINE



We often have a debate in our family about whether or not multi-tasking is something that people can actually do effectively. Admittedly, I am not very good at focusing on more than one thing at a time. If I am doing work on the computer, I can't be watching TV at the same time. If you are trying to talk to me, and I am on my phone, I am not really paying attention to you. I may register what you are saying to me, but I am not really taking it in. If I am cooking dinner and one of my children needs help with homework, either something gets burned, or someone doesn't get helped! "What do you mean?" you

may be thinking. "I can do more than one thing at once -- and I can do them both well! I have even changed clothes, or put on makeup in the car while driving!"

Well, it turns out that while many of us may think that we are excellent multi-taskers, there is at least *some* scientific data that does not support our belief. In an article that I read a few years ago written by Jon Hamilton, a science reporter for NPR, entitled *Think You're Multitasking? Think Again*, neurologist Earl Miller, a professor at MIT explains that:

People can't multitask very well, and when people say they can, they're deluding themselves. The brain is very good at deluding itself. What we can do, he said, is shift our focus from one thing to the next with astonishing speed. "Switching from task to task, you think you're actually paying attention to everything around you at the same time. But you're actually not. You're not paying attention to one or two things simultaneously, but switching between them very rapidly... For early humans, that sort of miscalculation could have meant becoming a tiger's lunch. These days, the consequences are more likely to be stress, a blunder — or maybe a car crash.

And what does all of this have to do with our Jewish lives? It turns out -- quite a bit because there are spiritual pitfalls that come along with trying to multi-task as well. Last month we celebrated the Festival of Shavuot, commemorating the revelation of the Torah on Mount Sinai. The Torah tells us that when God asked Moses to come up the mountain, God said:

"Come up to Me on the mountain **and be there (v'heyeh)**, and I will give you the stone tablets with the teachings and commandments which I have inscribed to instruct them." **Exodus 24:12** 

Why the redundancy here? Why the seemingly unnecessary phrase "and be there?" Rabbi Menachem Mendel of Kotzk explains that this seemingly superfluous phrase is necessary because it is proof that:

a person can exert tremendous effort to reach the top of a mountain, yet without being there. He may be standing on the mountain, but his head may be elsewhere. The main thing is not the ascent, but being there, and only there, and not to be below at the same time. **Rabbi Menahem Mendel of Kotzk, 1787-1859** 

In other words, God was reminding Moses that it was not enough to climb up the mountain to receive the Torah; God wanted Moses to be present in that moment. God was reminding Moses not to be distracted by the people waiting for him, by their concerns, or by anything that he forgot at the bottom of the mountain!

If distraction during revelation was a concern for Moses, how much more is this a challenge for each of us in our daily lives and our daily interactions? As Rabbi Edwin Goldberg explains:

To "be there" in the everyday happenings in life is no small task. So often we are mired in the past, in consideration of what we did or didn't do. Or we are anxious about the future. So often we are physically with someone but mentally off in another world, and an opportunity for true communication is squandered...to focus on the present is a great spiritual challenge... Olitzky, Forman, Restful Reflections

As we get into these months of summer, and hopefully find some down time along the beautiful Jersey shore, let us consider the message of this teaching. How can we learn to multi-task less and focus more? How can we learn to stay up on the mountain, in the moment, being present for all who we encounter during our daily lives? How can we learn to quiet our minds and avoid so many of the distractions, stresses, and anxieties that we encounter each and every day? How can we learn to be more like Moses, or Abraham, who when called by God, was able to answer "Hineni," here I am, present, in the moment.

May each of us strive to create the focus, discipline, and sense of inner peace needed to remain present throughout our daily interactions, as we strive to create a world of inner peace and limit the stresses and distractions of our lives.




