From Transactional To Relational Judaism



A few years ago, I was shopping in bookstore on the Upper West Side of Manhattan (surprise!) when a woman walked into the store, asking the owners if they had a Torah for "rent." She explained that her son was having a bar mitzvah at a hotel and she needed to rent a scroll for the occasion. The owner politely said that his store does not rent Torah scrolls, that they had once upon a time, but there had been many problems, including the insurance liability. The woman was clearly very aggravated, miffed that another place she found that did

in fact rent Torahs had quoted her what she deemed to be an exorbitant amount, and she just said, "well, I just don't understand why you won't do it if **the consumer** wants to pay for it?"

As I walked out of the store, I remember having a moment of clarity in which I understood one of the major challenges of our time living in 21st-century America as Jews. There are simply too many people today who see Judaism as "transactional" instead of "relational."

Transactional Judaism is about cost. It is about what I will get for what I "give." Transactional Judaism says: I come to synagogue; I pay my dues so that my son can have a bar mitzvah. Transactional Judaism says: My mother is getting older; I had better join a synagogue so that I will have a rabbi available to do her funeral.

Relational Judaism is different. It is not about cost, but rather about people, about meaning, connection, and a sense of belonging. In relational Judaism, I pledge a certain amount to my synagogue community because I feel a part of *my* community, I value what *my* community stands for, and I feel like an active participant in *my* community. In relational Judaism, I join a synagogue so that I will have people there for me to walk me through my grief, celebrate with me in moments of joy, share life's daily joys and struggles with me. In relational Judaism, I need a rabbi because I want to learn, to find a teacher, and to find someone who can empower *me* to take hold of *my* tradition with love, guidance, compassion, and wisdom (at least that's what we try to do!).

To put it simply: Relational Judaism is focused on connection. Transactional Judaism is focused on cost.

This brings me to the upcoming summer months and the amount of time that all of us will be spending in the sand. Yes, the sand. You see, Relational Judaism is sacred, it is *kadosh*, it is holy. And what is the opposite of *kadosh* in Hebrew? The Hebrew word is *hol*, meaning profane or ordinary. But hol literally means "sand." As my teacher Rabbi Ed Feinstein teaches, *hol* is something that has no cohesion and no connection. It has nothing bonding it together. In many senses, we live in a world of *hol* each and every day: a world of individuals who are not connected, who are lonely, who often walk through life engaging in transactions instead of engaging in relationships. While transactions can have their place, a sacred community -- a community that is *kadosh* -- should be the opposite.

Our Torat El family exists to bring a sense of *kadosh* into the lives of our members. We exist to help each of you foster relationships and make deeper connections to yourself, to one another, to the wisdom and values of your tradition, and to your God. Judaism is not something that can be purchased. We are not "selling" anything here. That type of thinking is the world of *hol*, the world of sand. This summer, and entering into the New Year next fall, I invite you to remember that we are here to help you foster a closer relationship to your Judaism and to all for which it stands. As a relational community, and not a transactional one, we are here to give you a sense of belonging and not just a place to belong.

And how might you do that? By taking a step into our community. By deepening your involvement if you are already involved. By remembering that we exist as a place for you to come in from the sand, find a place to connect, to learn, to grow, to mourn, and to celebrate all that is *kadosh*, sacred, in this world and in your life.

Come and join us. Return home. But remember the most important rule of living on the shore -- first, wipe off the sand before coming in.




LIBRARY CHAI LITES




