

From The Rabbi's Study...

Don't Forget To Vote- It's A Mitzvah!



When I was growing up, our local voting station was in the garage of the house next door. I have fond memories of walking with my mother to Mrs. Sweeny's house each time there was an election. I especially liked getting a sticker to show everyone that my family had voted that day! But somehow this excitement about voting diminished as I grew older, and throughout my early voting years, I became somewhat apathetic about voting. It was not until my years in Rabbinical School that I began to realize the error of my ways, recognizing that as both Jews and Americans we have the responsibility and the privilege to take this opportunity seriously. That is why each of us must find some time to vote on Election Day, Tuesday November 2.

While we might not normally think of voting as a Jewish issue, concern and involvement with our government is long standing Jewish value. The Mishnah in Pirkei Avot, 3:3 teaches us to:

Pray for the welfare of the government, for were it not for fear of it, people would swallow each other alive.

Indeed in line with this Mishnah, on Shabbat it has become a tradition in our community to take a few moments to recite a Prayer for our Country based on the words of Rabbi Louis Ginzberg, one of the greatest Talmudists and legal minds of our movement and of Judaism in the 20th century. But praying for the welfare of our government is not enough.

As Jews, we must actively take part in allowing our voices to be heard when it comes to the formation of our government. This is in line with the general Jewish value placed on being an active member of the greater community. The sage Hillel put it best when he taught: "Do not separate yourself from the community (Avot 2:5)." As Jews the value which we place on community is seen in the way in which we eat, pray, and study. Voting is no different.

Being a part of the community does not mean losing our individuality. Even Hillel was aware that we should constantly strive to strike a balance between our individual concerns and the concerns of the greater community. This is made clear by another teaching from Pirkei Avot:

If I am not for myself, who will be for me? But if I am only for myself-what am I? And if not now, when? (Avot 1:14).

While we must vote taking our own interests into concern, we must also remember that we are voting based on what we feel is best for our country as a whole. Additionally, we must try not to allow pessimism, or excuses like "I don't like any of the candidates," or "my vote doesn't really count anyway," to get in our way of doing the right thing and voting in this election. As Hillel reminds us, we must take an active role in adding our voice to the broader community- "If not now, when."

Our first High Holy Days as a unified congregation are now behind us and I hope you feel as good as I do about what went on. Over the coming months, our Board members will be attending various synagogue functions and will be surveying you on what you would like Torat El to be and to do for you. I encourage you to engage us in this discussion so that we can make Torat El as user friendly as possible. A good friend and professional mentor of mine reminded me of these words of wisdom: ***Tell me and I'll forget; show me and I may remember; involve me and I'll understand.***

I hope you will take these words to heart and get involved as we write the next chapter of the story of Torat El. Together, we can take this congregation at its infancy to create an institution that has meaning, value, and attractiveness to you, bonding you with more than 1,300 other people with a common heritage and desire to be closer to each other and the Almighty.

We're off to a great start. With your help, our congregation will be here better than ever for our elders, ourselves, and our youth. The future of Conservative Judaism at the Jersey Shore is right here, right now, and very, very exciting.



Exploring Our Jewish Journeys **Taught by Rabbi Schonbrun**


