ENGAGING THE SERVICE OF THE HEART



Many years ago, when I was a rabbinical student, I found myself attending a seminar on leading vibrant and meaningful *tefilah* (prayer) with the Rabbis and Cantors at B'nai Jeshurun (BJ) on the Upper West Side. Together with classmates from both JTS (Conservative) and HUC (Reform) we gathered around these more experienced clergy, waiting to soak up the wisdom and find out what they were doing to get over 1000 people attending Friday night services every week! What was making these services so powerful and engaging? *It had to be the musical instruments, and the incredible power behind the music* – many of us thought to ourselves.

"It's not only the music or the instruments," the Senior Rabbi said. People think it's just about the music, but it's not. It's the feeling that is created and promoted in the room during prayer. The music can drive that feeling, but not always.

In other words, while musical instruments may help create a sense of deep feeling, connection to prayer, and holiness, there are also instances where services with musical instruments are performative and not engaging. Fortunately, in our community, whether it is through Shabbat at the Beach, an occasional Friday night music service, or the incredible weekend that we had last month with Rabbi Josh Warshawsky, we have worked steadily over these past few years to create occasional musical services that are engaging, and not simply a performance. Of course, these services are not engaging for everyone, and may even be challenging for some people. We have members who enjoy Shabbat services and weekday minyanim just the way they are. We have others who would prefer more English. And still others who might like a cantor, or even more music, or perhaps some quiet meditation. When it comes to discovering ways to help people access *tefilah* in a deeper way, it is not about any singular "trick" per se. That is what the rabbis at BJ were telling us as students so many years ago. The question is not whether "music services 'work." I believe that they can be incredibly powerful and we will be looking to continue on the sacred work that we have done in this area in the coming years. But this is not an article about musical services alone. It is instead about how we might continue to create more opportunities for our members to take ownership over their prayer lives. How might we be able to help anyone who is interested, foster a deeper sense of connection with that which is sacred in this world?

This is not a small question, but as I have written before, it is one that we should grapple with more openly and frequently as a *beit tefilah*, a house of prayer, not necessarily to "replace" our current practice but rather to widen our tent, and promote more options for people to experiment with their prayer lives both at home and in the synagogue.

So consider this an invitation to do just that. As we approach the summer, I want to encourage you to join us for our first Shabbat at the Beach on June 23 at 7:00PM. Throughout the summer, and into the new year (that will come soon enough), consider joining us for a prayer service during the week, on Zoom in the evenings, during Shabbat or a holiday. Consider taking just 5-10 minutes a week to stop and "pray" at home in whatever way is meaningful to you. If you want to talk about what this might look like, or need some advice, give me a call or send me an email. If you find that you connect in prayer in ways that we do not yet offer, call me about that as well. Again, whether you are a "regular" or someone who comes once a year, whether you can read Hebrew or can't, whether you are sure about God or you are not, whether you like a 30-minute service or a two-hour-and-30-minute service; whether you like musical instruments or you do not, whether you are a regular "pray-er" or not, the goal is to try to deepen our engagement to the role that the Divine might play in our lives; to strive to awaken our hearts and our souls to the deep senses of gratitude, humility, and responsibility that go along with being a member of the Jewish people. As Rabbi Warshawsky taught us, the goal is to take prayer seriously, to allow ourselves to be open, and changed, by the act of praying. Prayer can change us quite profoundly, but only if we are willing to take it seriously; only if we are willing to take a risk, to go out of our comfort zone, and to engage as individuals, and as a community, with a deep and serious practice of prayer, or as our ancient sages called it *the service of the heart*.


