COMBATting IGNORANCE ABOUT ISRAEL



In the nearly three months since October 7th, we have witnessed a rise in anti-Semitism in this country that has been shocking and upsetting on many levels. While this is unfortunately not new, the brazenness with which it has manifested has been incredibly difficult for all of us to watch and experience. Chief among these incidents are the scenes from rallies on and off of college campuses that are supposedly on behalf of the Palestinian people – but in reality are anything but. These gatherings often end up being anti-Israel, anti-Semitic, and not helpful to a cause that would one day see a Palestinian state living side by side Israel in peace. What has been tremendously upsetting for me to watch (in addition to the obvious and odious hatred that is espoused in these gatherings), is the level of ignorance that is so evident among the participants. This ignorance was pointed out clearly in a wonderful article written by Ron Hassner in the *WSJ* entitled “From Which River To Which Sea.” In the article, Hassner pointed out the ignorance that he discovered in a poll of 250 students from a variety of backgrounds across the U.S. concluding that

“In all, after learning a handful of basic facts about the Middle East, 67.8% of students went from supporting “from the river to the sea” to rejecting the mantra. These students had never seen a map of the Mideast and knew little about the region’s geography, history, or demography. Those who hope to encourage extremism depend on the ignorance of their audiences.”

We are witnessing a toxic combination of ignorance when it comes to the Israeli/Palestinian situation and the history of Israel, combined with anti-Semitism in this country and around the world. One of the most painful videos that I have seen in the past few months is one of a college student taking down posters of the hostages because she claimed that they were somehow “propaganda.” The kicker – the student was Jewish! While I cannot do much about the anti-Semites of the world, as a Jewish educator I couldn’t help but wonder where we had failed with this child. I am all for promoting a narrative about Israel that is thoughtful and nuanced. The situation in the Middle East is incredibly complex and there is plenty of blame, historically, to spread around. And while the blame in this moment clearly rests with Hamas, I worry about the ignorance (particularly among Jewish people) that will persist when this moment has, God willing, faded into the background.

How much do you know and understand about Israel and her history? How much do your children and grandchildren understand about Israel? Where do you go to educate yourselves about this topic so that you can both understand and defend our people against false and biased accusations that are not based in reality or historical fact? For those of you who are interested, here are a few suggestions. To understand more about Israel try the following books: *Israel*, by Noa Tishby (quick read; she is also on Instagram, consider following her), *Israel, A Concise History* by Daniel Gordis (longer read), *Catch ‘67* by Micah Goodman (a quick read explaining the left/right split historically in Israel), or *Like Dreamers* by Yossi Klein-Halevi (long; about the reunification of Jerusalem and the stories of Israeli Paratroopers who reunited a nation). For news, check out jpost.com, timesofisrael.com, ynetnews.com. For thoughtful discussions about everything Israel, check out the Shalom Hartman Institute Listen to their podcasts (Identity Crisis, and For Heaven’s Sake are both excellent). For some short videos online that are also very good, go to <https://unpacked.education/register/free/> to sign up for videos that are used to teach and explain all things Israel. Great for history, balanced, and short videos that are useful in understanding the issues. These are just a few resources to get you started. Because while we cannot control all of the ignorance and hatred that is out there, we can make sure that we have the tools that we need to educate ourselves about Israel as she continues to fight for her right to self-determination as a homeland for the Jewish people.

May this new year bring peace and calm to the region, as Israel fights a war that it did not seek, and may the hostages that remain in Gaza soon be returned home.

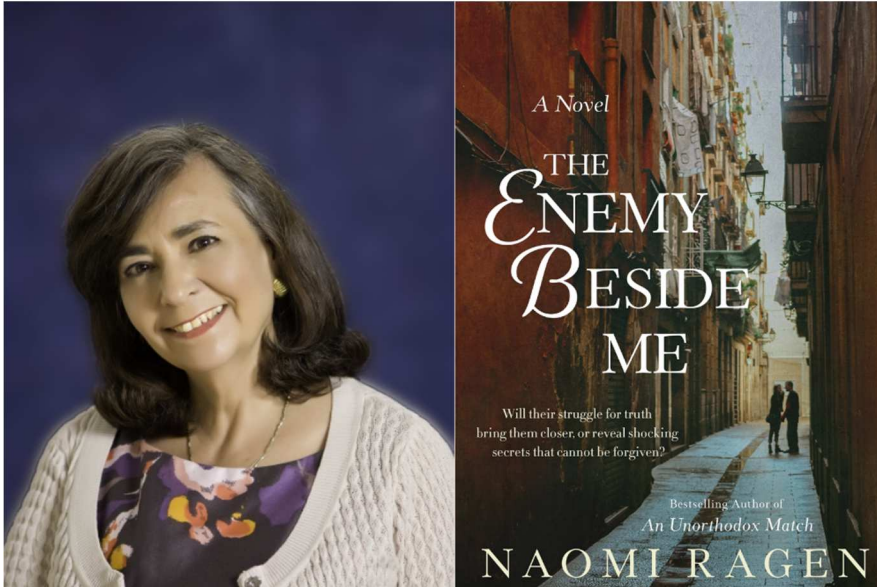

Meet Naomi Ragen, author of *The Enemy Beside Me*



Taking over from her father as head of an organization whose purpose is to bring Nazi war criminals to justice, Milia Gottstein has dedicated her life to making sure the voices of Holocaust victims will never be silenced. This overwhelming mission has usurped her passion and energy, leaving little time for her personal life. Just as she prepares to leave her job, she accepts an invitation as keynote speaker at a Holocaust

conference in Lithuania, a country that has not only engaged in Holocaust distortion and refused to educate their children as to the true role their country played in the annihilation of its Jewish population, but has also continued to honor mass murderers.

This powerful and provocative novel is not only about the Lithuanian-Nazi collaboration and distortion of history, but also the wider topic of what the relationship today should be between the children of survivors and those of perpetrators.

Naomi Ragen is an American author and playwright who has lived in Jerusalem since 1971. She is an outspoken advocate for women's rights and an active combatant against anti-Israel and anti-Semitic propaganda through her website.

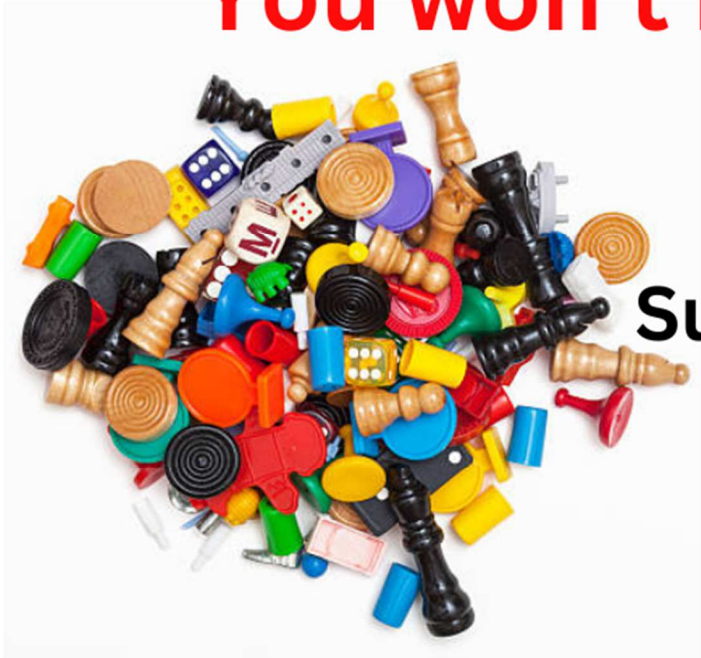

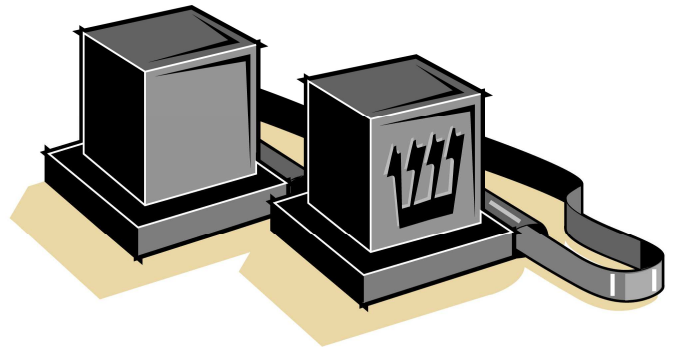
