LISTENING THROUGH THE NOISE



Purim is a loud holiday. Anyone who has ever attended a traditional Megillah reading, complete with groggers and children shouting whenever Haman's name is mentioned, knows that this is one of the few nights when our evening service is noisy and raucous. The irony, of course, is that one of the central mitzvot of Purim is to *listen* to the Megillah being read. We are not obligated to listen as closely to the weekly Torah or Haftarah readings, but when it comes to the Megillah, we are specifically commanded to pay careful attention. How, then, are we supposed to listen through all of the noise?

This question has been asked throughout history. According to Rabbi David Golinkin, as the custom of making noise on Purim became more widespread, as early as the 13th century, there were many who objected to the practice.

Many rabbis said that the noise bothers the reader and the worshippers... while others warn(ed) that that it arouses anti-Semitism or derision by the Gentiles... Others said that it destroys the benches and the floor of the synagogue and is also dangerous...

In 1783, the Ma'amad (Board) of the Spanish-Portuguese congregation in London ruled that anyone making a disturbance was to be evicted from the synagogue after the police became involved in a brawl in the synagogue!

All of this raises an important question. How are we meant to listen on Purim, and in life, amid so much noise? I think about this often in terms of our phones, which constantly demand our attention with rings, notifications, TV shows, podcasts, and music, sometimes from multiple devices at once! We live in an age of continual noise and distraction, where calm, quiet, and contemplative spaces can be difficult to find. The tension between "making noise" and "listening" on Purim invites us to ask how we might create space for listening amid the din that surrounds us.

How might we learn to listen more fully, with fewer distractions? How can we pay closer attention to what truly matters in any given moment? In Hebrew, to pay attention is *sim lev*, literally, to "place the heart." It means directing our heart fully toward the person with whom we are engaging and striving to be truly present. To do this, we must first notice what pulls us away. Are we distracted by our phones during meetings? Is our mind racing through a to-do list? Does discomfort with eye contact, or our constant sense of being "on the go" prevent us from slowing down long enough to listen? Or is our ego out of balance, telling us that what we have to say can't wait, that it's more important, or that we've "heard this before?"

I cannot claim that any of this is easy. While I have learned to listen more effectively over the course of my rabbinate, this is something I still struggle with. Active listening, especially in a world full of distractions, requires practice, discipline, and a calming of the mind. And even when I *hear* what someone is saying, I am not always truly listening (just ask my family).

The Hebrew word *Megillah* literally means "scroll," but it is also connected to a root meaning "to reveal" or "to uncover." As Purim approaches, may we remember that while noise and distraction will always be part of life, each of us has the ability to construct calm amidst the chaos. By creating the right conditions, we can open our ears, and our hearts, to what is waiting to be "uncovered and revealed." May each of us strive to listen carefully and refocus thoughtfully, despite the noise of the everyday *groggers* that surround us.
